PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS/INFORMATION

Kiewit contacted Stephens and Smith regarding the need for a stamped pool deck. 8' x 8' samples were created with different colors and patterns for the customer to choose from. The owner decided to choose the English Sidewalk Slate pattern for the field and Ashlar Slate pattern for the frame/border for the middle of the patio and pool coping. It was a large remodel project that required the existing patio and pool deck to be removed. Recycled concrete fines were brought in for a good base. The shape of the pool ended up being about the same as the old one but some borders were added for a bit more distinction. Stephens and Smith used #4 rebar 2' o.c. for reinforcement and the concrete mix was a 3,500 psi with 10% limestone. The project provided a challenge in pouring due to the patio/pool deck being 400'-500' away from the street leaving Stephens and Smith to rely on using a power-buggy for everything.
