

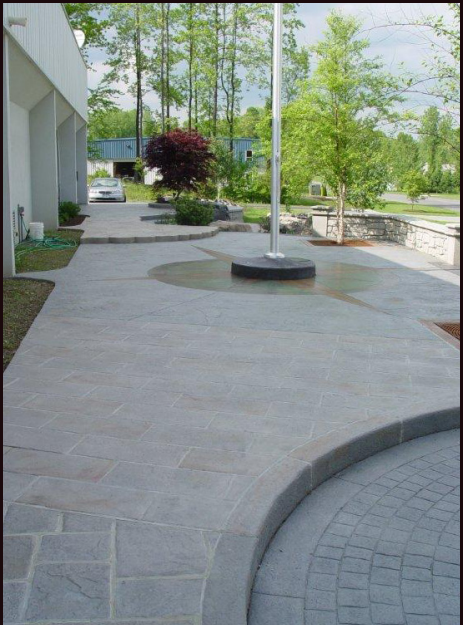

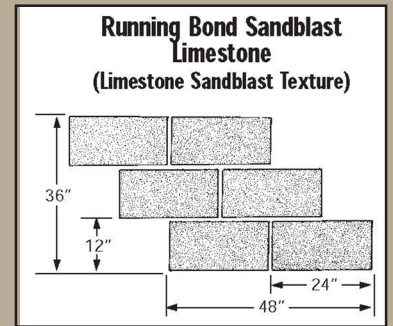

## RUNNING BOND SANDBLAST LIMESTONE



The Bomaron Running Bond Sandblast Limestone Pattern can be used in a variety of applications from outdoor driveways to residential walkways and shopping plazas. The pattern encompasses a standard 24" x 12" rectangular size alternating brick look but with a sandy textured finish. The Limestone Sandblast Texture is the same texture as the Limestone but with a lightly sandblasted face creating a slightly more angular feel with a uniform sandstone texture with minimal depth of relief and no veining. The Running Bond Sandblast Limestone Tool can be used in conjunction with other coordinating patterns for an interesting separation of areas.
