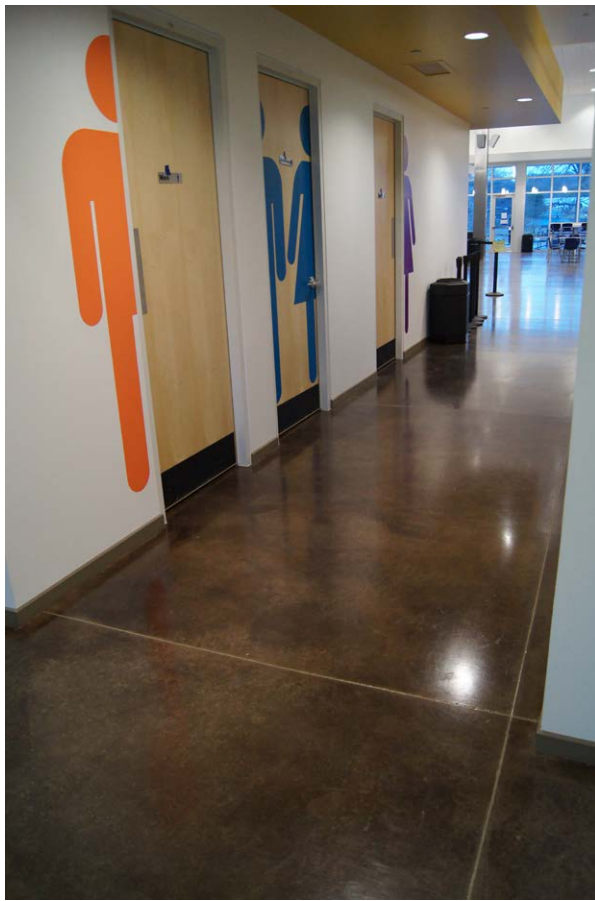

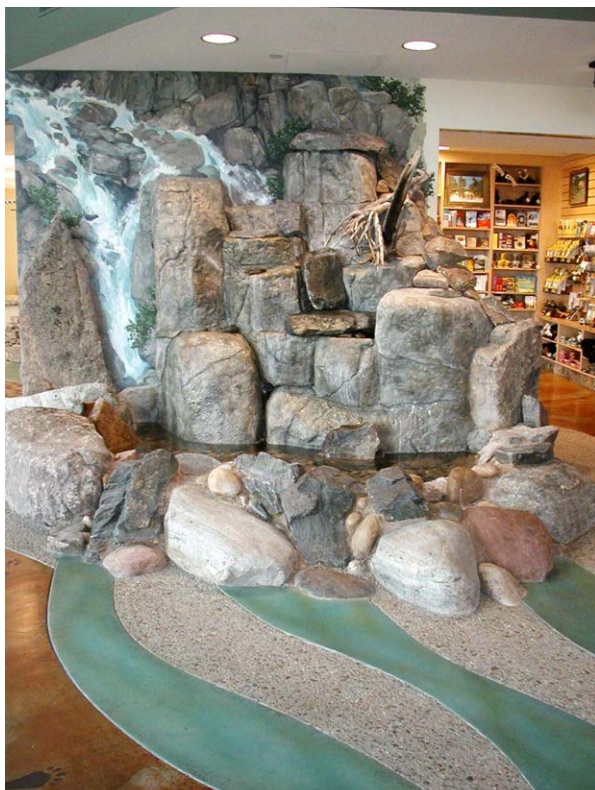

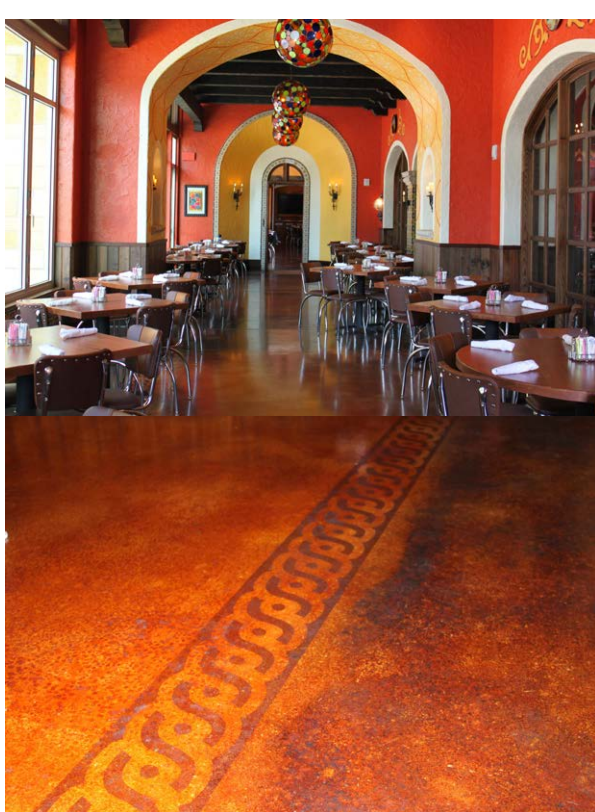
ORU-Armand Hammer Alumni Student Center
